GENERATOR IS ON ITS WAY TO PNG DENTAL PROJECT - 'SEPIK DENTAL CLINIC'

Donation of Generator for Kenthurst Rotary Club Dental Clinic, Sepik River, Northern PNG

Two weeks ago, Brookvale & Dee Why Warringah Rotary Clubs had a presentation from Karo who is a member of the Kenthurst Rotary Club, regarding the establishment of a Dental Clinic at a village on the Sepik River in Papua New Guinea, where Karo was raised as a child.

This region of PNG houses over 200,000 residents in villages along the Sepik River, which winds itself northwest from Wewak into the interior of this very rugged part of the country.

Currently these residents have no dedicated Dental Clinic and patients have to wait a long time to see a medical nurse to obtain treatment, and this is normally just a painkiller.

Karo and her team are gathering up equipment and supplies to fill a container in Sydney that will be shipped to Wewak, where it will be unloaded and the contents taken by canoe to the site where the clinic is being constructed.

The building materials for the clinic are being sourced from local timber donated by villages along the river and milled to the correct lengths locally.

One of the items that they require, is an engine powered generator to power the dental equipment and provide lighting to enable the visiting dentists to treat the patients.

Fortuitously, I have a new 8 kilowatt diesel powered generator that was earmarked for my business on Norfolk Island, but with the current shipping crisis I have been unable to get it to the island and we have now made other arrangements to supply backup power for our communications room.

I spoke to my business partner and we have agreed to donate this generator to the PNG Project and I expect they will organise to have it collected in the near future for inclusion in the container at Kenthurst Rotary Club.

I can't think of a more worthwhile project and considering Australia's strong ties to the region, I feel its giving something back to those who provided so much assistance to the Australian Defence Force as they pushed the Japanese invaders out of PNG during World War 2.


