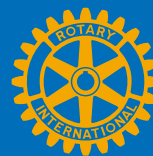

Daniel Dummer was our guest speaker on Tuesday night. Daniel was a champion university debater who now works in education, while serving as Youth Director at the Rotary Club of Beecroft and Co-Director of our District's Summer RYPEN camp.

“Dr Gordon Lau is continuing as our veteran co-director of 15 years, and we have two new high school graduates joining as facilitators,” Daniel said. *“So our team brings an amazing range of experiences and expertise to help students grow as individuals and as leaders this year.”*

After completing a Bachelor of Arts (Politics and International Relations) at Macquarie University, Daniel co-founded Speaking Schools Australasia and was Master-in-Charge of Debating, Public Speaking, Mock Trial, Mooting* and Toastmasters at a high school. He also worked for two federal MPs before returning to education.

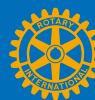
In his current role as Pathfinder Program Manager at Art of Smart Education, he supports students to build study, wellbeing and career skills. He also co-authored The New University Entry Game to help students maximise their opportunities after school.

Daniel facilitated one of RYPEN’s interactive games, the Opinion Card Challenge, so that all our club members present could get a taste of the experience for students. He offered a range of controversial statements (from ice cream flavours to Good Samaritans to dating!) and we each shared our stances, gaining a better understanding of how our unique life experiences have shaped our values and perceptions.

Daniel traced his leadership journey to attending RYLA in 2014, so he encouraged us to continue supporting students to attend Rotary’s youth programs, while sharing how RYPEN has adapted to remain current and offer students an enriching experience on **3-5 February 2023**.

Hello Everyone

Well, we're finally on our way home and expect to be back in Sydney in about 2 weeks. We are into week 31 of our travels, have clocked up 31,000kms and I have identified almost 150 different types of birds.

Our last stop in WA was Esperance. It was nice weather at first and the water was so blue. It was stunning (icy cold) but not much to do there.

We had booked to stay at Lucky Bay for 4 nights which was even more stunning but Cape Arid National Park and the shortcut across to the Nullarbor were closed. The final straw was the weather forecast, gale force winds, rain, max 14 degrees etc for several days.

So we changed plans, packed up and headed east. The wind at our back pushed us across the Nullarbor in under 2 days. The next night we stayed in Streaky Bay SA, the van shook and rocked violently in the wind. Eventually the rains, wind and cold passed.

We're now in Coffin Bay, see the photo from our annex in the National Park campground, it is quiet with great walks, wildlife abounds with more emus than you can count. Today we're going to try some local oysters.

A few more stops then we're back in NSW, hopefully the flood waters will allow us to call in and see my cousins at West Wyalong & Milthorpe.

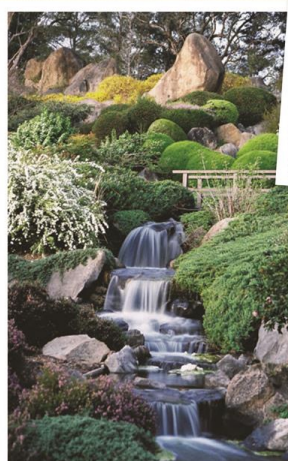

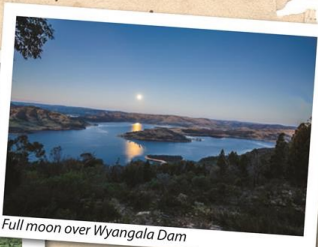

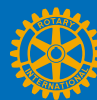
